NOTES

Recognizably bright and nuanced. The House Blanc highlights fresh citrus, ripe stone fruits peppered in with wet stone minerality and savory toasty notes. With a brut dosage, the Rendition #1 uses reserve wines to soften the acidity and create a richer honeysuckle impression. Nearly all Chardonnay coming from three diverse sites makes the House Blanc a great representation of what Washington can bring to the world of sparkling wines.
